



## **RESOLUTION 002**

Calling on Housing to Address Requirement for Students to Move Possessions Out of Dorms Over Semester Breaks

WHEREAS, the United Tribes Technical College (UTTC) Student Government Association (SGA) is vested with the authority to be the voice for the student body; and,

WHEREAS, SGA has the responsibility of addressing student concerns on campus and;

WHEREAS, students have raised concerns regarding having to move their possessions out of their dorm rooms over the semester breaks and;

WHEREAS, students have a limited number of options available for storing their personal possessions during this move-out period and;

WHEREAS, students who have found local storage for their personal possessions have had possessions damaged and/or stolen and;

WHEREAS, many students rely on catching rides home over the break and are not able to transport their possessions and;

WHEREAS, family members have driven long distances to campus to pick up the students' possessions and then have to again drive long distances to return the student and their possessions after the break and;

WHEREAS, students have been told by Housing staff that dorm rooms need to be cleaned over the break so their personal possessions need to be removed and;

WHEREAS, SGA believes students are more likely to return to campus after the semester break if their personal possessions can remain in their dorm rooms.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Student Government Association hereby presents this resolution to the Vice President for Campus Services as well as the Housing Director and;

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that SGA requests formal acknowledgement of this resolution and;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that SGA requests a change in procedure that will allow students who pass weekly dorm inspections to leave their personal possessions in their dorm rooms over the semester breaks and not be required to remove these possessions.
