- A. I, the undersigned, am the student, parent/legal guardian, and high school administrator/designee, of the above individual. By signing this form, I consent to the student's enrollment in dual credit or early entry course(s) with United Tribes Technical College.
- B. I understand that the student must receive a final grade of "C" or higher to earn college credit. Students who receive a "D", "F", "Withdrawal", or "Dropped" grade will receive a grade earned on their transcript; however, it will be below UTTC's minimum passing grade standard and will not be given college credit. College courses in which a student earned a "D" are generally not transferable to other higher education institutions.
- C. If the high school has a different grading requirement, that school has the authority to determine what a passing grade is for their institution. A numerical grade will appear on the high school transcript and the conversion of grades is the responsibility of the student's respective high school. The student is responsible for verifying the transferability of courses to their prospective college or university.
- D. If a student elects to withdraw from any of their college courses it is their responsibility to first talk to their designated high school advocate or Monarch Project Student Success Coach. If the decision to withdraw is then made, the student will contact the UTTC Early College Coordinator. Students must follow the Academic Calendar for important academic-related dates such as the first day of classes, add/drop dates, etc.
- E. For students who are eligible and receive financial assistance through the Bank of North Dakota's Dual Credit Assistance Program or through the United Tribes Technical College Monarch Project, the student must earn a "C" or higher in their dual credit course(s) to continue receiving dual credit financial assistance.
- F. To enroll in a College Math and/or College English the student must achieve the required placement scores (ACCUPLACER or ACT).
- G. Early College applicants must meet UTTC's eligibility requirements which include GPA, full completion of UTTC's application, submission of all admission documents, and the completion of the Early College online orientation.
